# TEE TIME IN IRELAND WITH JIMMY HANLIN — OUTLINE ITINERARY

## SAT, JUL 9- UNITED STATES TO DUBLIN

Depart your hometown and take an overnight flight across the Atlantic.

## SUN, JUL 10- SHANNON ARRIVAL & GOLF AT DOONBEG

Welcome to Ireland! Land at Shannon Airport where you pass immigration control, pick up your baggage and go through customs. In the Arrivals Hall meet your Driver/Guide who will welcome you to Ireland and escort you to the nearby Inn at Dromoland for a hearty full Irish breakfast. Then board your motor coach to travel west to Doonbeg. Check into your hotel and settle into your room. Tee off at Doonbeg, the product of the creative genius of Greg Norman. Designed along the towering dunes on a crescent of Ireland's famed southwestern shore, it plays along 1.5 miles of beach and dunes and the par 72 layout features a single loop of nine holes out and nine back. It plays 6,800 yards from the back tees. After your round of golf the balance of the day is at leisure.

## MON, JUL 11- CLIFFS OF MOHER & LAHINCH GOLF COURSE

This morning after a hearty Irish breakfast, drive to the coast of Clare to view the Cliffs of Moher. This impressive wall of rock rises to almost 700 feet above the foaming Atlantic breakers. Next, travel to Lahinch. Enjoy a round of golf with your group at Lahinch Golf Course. Lahinch has hosted every important Irish amateur fixture and has been in existence for over 100 years. The two most challenging and controversial holes are the Klondyke (5th) with its blind second shot over the sand dune and Dell (6th) surrounded on three sides by steep dunes. This is one of Ireland's most popular and invigorating courses. Return to Doonbeg and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure.

## TUE, JUL 12- GOLF AT BALLYBUNION

This morning, drive to Tarbert where you take a ferry across the wide mouth of the River Shannon. Enjoy golf with your group at Ballybunion Old Course. The Old Course was a great favorite with Tom Watson in the 1980's and is noted for the massive sandhills which make the course great fun. Then ferry back across the River Shannon and return to your hotel in Doonbeg. The evening is free for individual pursuits and dining.

## WED, JUL 13- BLARNEY CASTLE & MIDDLETON DISTILLERY

After breakfast, travel south through the county of Cork to Blarney. Stop to climb to the battlements of Blarney Castle to kiss the famous "Stone of Eloquence." Also visit the Blarney Woollen Mills, which has an excellent range of Irish products of all types. They will ship and insure goods for you. You will also have time to browse around the village, charmingly set around a large village green. Then drive to Middleton to visit the Old Middleton Distillery.

Walk through the old buildings and see the largest pot still in the world while your guide explains how whiskey is made. At the end of your tour, enjoy a sampling of the finished product. Continue on to Killarney and check into your hotel. You may wish to freshen up or relax before dining with your group tonight.

## THU, JUL 14- TRALEE & KILLARNEY

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel. Today play a round of golf at Tralee golf course. This creation of Arnold Palmer and Ed Seay offers not only fine golf, but surely some of the most beautiful scenery in Ireland. Several of the holes are perched on cliff edges with spectacular views along the Dingle Peninsula. This is a course of tremendous variety, requiring all the shots you know and more. After your round of golf enjoy some time at leisure to explore Tralee. Then return to Killarney and enjoy the rest of the day to sightsee, shop and dine on your own.

## FRI, JUL 15- GOLF AT WATERVILLE & RING OF KERRY

This morning after breakfast drive to Waterville for a round of golf with your fellow travelers. At the tip of the Ring of Kerry, this course of 7,234 yards makes it one of Europe's longest and toughest links. The feature holes are the par-five 11th which runs for 487 yards along a rugged valley and the par-three 17th with a tee poised above the landscape. Surrounded by the Atlantic Ocean on three sides, the prevailing southwesterly wind is a factor to take into account. After golf continue exploring the Ring of Kerry with miles of marvelous scenery consisting of the highest peaks in Ireland on one side and a coastline scattered with golden beaches and rocky headlands on the other. As you drive, every turn will reveal new vistas of mountains, cliffs and beaches and there will be plenty of photo stops. Return to Killarney where the evening is free for individual pursuits and dining.

## SAT, JUL 16- KILLARNEY AT LEISURE

After a hearty Irish breakfast enjoy the day at leisure to explore Killarney. For those interested in golf, today's round will be on the championship inland course of Killeen, which was established in 1986. Killeen is located on the shores of Killarney's lakes and is popular for major Irish events. The lush fairways tend to play longer than their yardage would suggest and the course makes the most of its natural aspect.
